Students who perform at or show the potential for performing at an outstanding level of accomplishment are identified using multiple assessments. Students, parents and teachers may nominate students and complete an application to begin the process. This application includes a Teacher Checklist that focuses on the behaviors expected of a high ability student. Parents provide report cards and copies of standardized test scores. Tests are administered to gauge additional potential to excel. A committee studies and discusses the information in each applicant's folder to determine whether high ability placement is recommended for the student.
